

Dear Parent

Please find below information with regards to your child's return to school.

We have worked extremely hard to ensure that the safety of our pupils is the best it can possibly be.

The children will attend school for the 3-week period from Monday 29th June 2020 to Friday 17th July 2020. They will be allocated specific days within each of the 3 weeks.

We have grouped the children into small bubble groups and these groups will stay the same for the 3 weeks your child is in school meaning they will only ever mix with the same children and adults. We have staggered the start and finish times of the school day, staggered our lunchtimes and playtimes ensuring that the bubbles do not mix at any times. This means the risk of cross contamination is greatly reduced.

Each class has allocated bubbles which will attend on consecutive days. (ie days that are next to each other)

These are as follows:

For your child's specific days and bubbles please see your class platform. E.g. seesaw/google classroom	

It is also essential to stagger our start/end of day to minimise the number of parents on site at any 1 time.

If your child is in Reception/Year 1/Year 2/Year6 you will enter the school at your given time via the gate from the carpark directly onto the school yard. You will be asked to walk around the perimeter of the yard where staff will guide your child into their class. You will leave the yard through the small wooden side gate and leave the premises via the staff carpark gate. There will be staff there for the first week helping and directing this procedure.

Children from Year 5/Year 4/ Year 3 will enter the school via the Prince Charles Road gate and leave via the emergency double gates ensuring you do not pass one another. There will be signage reminding you of the 2M distancing rule. Year 5 pupils will be taught by Mrs A Thomas as Mrs Nicholls is still shielding. Therefore, you will enter school through the Year 4 door.

Uniform

It is not necessary for your child to wear their uniform. We are asking that children come back in joggers/shorts and t shirts for their own comfort. The guidance states that at the end of each day your child should strip off the clothes they have worn in school as soon as they get home and that these clothes should be washed immediately to lower the risk of cross contamination. It is essential that clean clothes are worn each day to school.

Lunch

From the 29th June there will be NO canteen facility therefore **ALL** children must bring a packed lunch to school. Children who are free school meals should use the money that was allocated to provide a packed lunch for your child each day. In line with guidance we are asking that you send your child's packed lunch to school in a plastic carrier bag that can either be wiped down or thrown away each day. Any unfinished food will be disposed of and not returned home as we normally do. Therefore, can we request that food is wrapped and not in plastic containers.

Please can you also provide your child with a water bottle/drink to have on their desk as we will not be using the school ones.

Snack

We are unable to provide fruit at morning snacktime so please could you send a small healthy snack for your child each day.

Other information

Staff are unable to stand and talk on the yard so if you have any questions you are asked to email/ message or ring your class teacher

The school office is NOT open so again any queries need to be via the phone or email.

We hope that all this information is helpful and that you understand the need for all the rules and regulations.

We look forward to seeing you on your allocated days
