NO CHILD WILL START SCHOOL ON 1ST OR 2ND SEPTEMBER.

From Thursday 3rd September, Class 7, Nursery and Reception children will be staggered into school. Mrs Garnham, Mrs Harkin and Miss Davies will be in touch with information by the end of the week.

From Monday 7th September, children that haven't accessed bubbles this term or completed any online learning (in any year group) will have priority. Your child's class teacher will be in touch to inform you of the days he/she is expected to return to school during this week. There will be online learning opportunities for children not accessing school this week.

ALL children will return to school on Monday 14th September.

We appreciate that this is a very unsettling time for everyone, however at St Anne's there are very specific procedures in place to ensure the safety of all. We will continue with staggered starts and finishing times, staggered lunchbreaks and there will be no whole school gatherings. Toilet facilities are regularly cleaned and monitored and children will be expected to continue with their frequent handwashing and to keep social distancing requirements wherever they can.

I do hope this eases your mind when you send your children back to school. We want you and your children to be happy at school even though it's not what they may be used to. We hope that starting school in smaller groups, will ensure children feel safe and secure in school with the new procedures.
