



St Anne's Eisteddfod



As many of you know here at St Anne's we celebrate St David's Day with an Eisteddfod where the pupils compete and join in with class contributions for a whole school celebration. In the past we have had visitors in to play the harp, welsh dancers and welsh speakers to read and recite in the welsh language.

Due to the situation with covid we have not been able to do this for the past 2 years but have decided that this year we can still make March 1st a special day of welsh celebration.

Over the half term holiday we are asking children to make items for the class competitions and these will be judged by some of our governors and ex teachers.

In class we will be holding handwriting competitions and asking each class to learn a welsh song or rhyme.

On March 1st some of our pupils will be taking part in the parade through Wrexham town centre and then on the Friday March 4th we will be having a whole school ZOOM assembly to announce the winners of all of our class competitions and to hear each other's songs etc. This will be led by Mrs Hughes who will present using the welsh language throughout.

On March the 1st children may wear traditional welsh costumes and on Friday 5th we will ask all pupils to wear red or green which are traditional welsh colours.
